Shall Lawson Reorganized School District No. R-XIV of Ray County, Missouri, issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of \$6,000,000 for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, repairing, improving, extending, remodeling, renovating, furnishing and equipping new and existing school facilities, including but not limited to the following:

- Roofing replacements, bathroom renovations and plumbing upgrades at various District facilities
- Constructing a new main entrance and office suite at the Elementary School
- Secure entrance improvements at the Middle School
- ADA improvements at the High School gymnasium and Performing Arts Center
- Parking lot pavement and overlay
- Upgrading the Performing Arts Center lighting and sound systems
- Upgrading furniture and technology at various District facilities

If this proposition is approved, the District's debt service tax levy is estimated to remain unchanged at the current debt service tax levy of \$0.95 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
